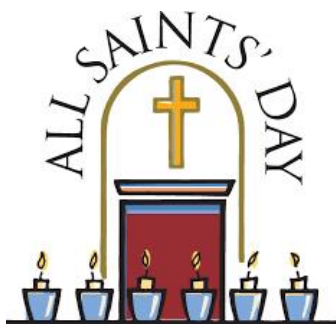


### LEAVING FOR WARMER CLIMATES?

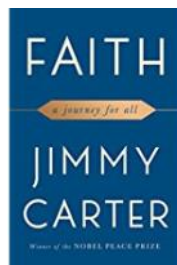
### CHRISTMAS PAGEANT REHEARSAL TODAY!

### HAVE YOU HAD YOUR FLU SHOT?

The flu season last year, 2017-2018 was the deadliest since 1976. There were record number of hospitalizations last year mostly in the over 65 year old age group. Flu vaccination is the best way to protect those at most risk. Last year the vaccine was only about 40%



effective but this year they have reformulated the vaccine and hope it will be more effective. It is best to get the vaccine before the end of October and it takes about 2 weeks before your body develops antibodies to the flu. Careful hand washing is a good practice for all of us to prevent contagion and keeping your mouth covered when coughing or sneezing important. The vaccine is recommended for ages 6 months and up, so please get your flu vaccine this year. Your Health and Spirituality Committee
