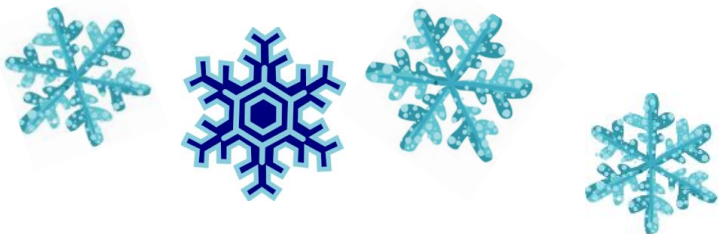

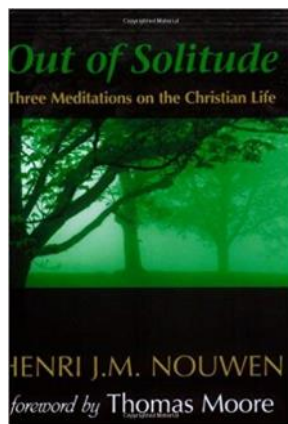
again. For 2019, our goal is **500 good**
