

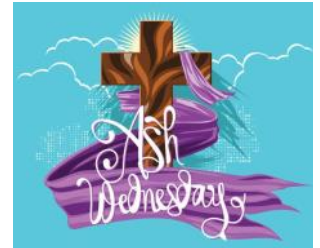
SAVE THE DATE!
