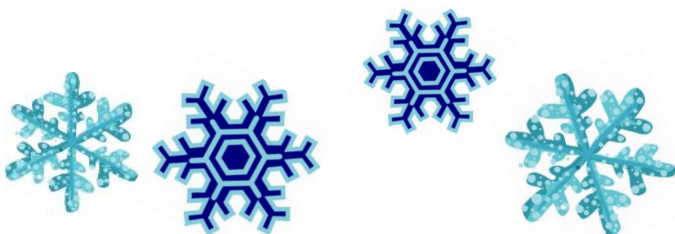

FILL AN EASTER BASKET FOR A YOUTH AT WOODSIDE

Woodside is a juvenile rehabilitation center serving youth ages 10 to 17 who are in the Dept. of Children and Family custody. The youth at Woodside may have delinquency charges, exhibit harmful behavior towards themselves or others and require significant treatment intervention. As part of the mission outreach at Shelburne UMC, we provide Easter Baskets filled with items that may help to brighten a day and perhaps give hope to youth who find themselves at Woodside. Empty baskets will be available on Sunday March 31. Take a basket and fill it. Suggested items include Easter Candy, playing cards, deodorant, non-electric games, books, pens & pencils, socks, shampoo. Baskets must be returned by Sunday, April 14th in order for them to be delivered before Easter Sunday. **NOT PERMITTED: ANYTHING WITH METAL PARTS OR WIRES, GUM, NOR STRINGS, NOTHING CONTAINING ALCOHOL AND NO AEROSOL CANS.**
