

How to make a worship video:

1. You need a digital video recording device. **Examples:** A smartphone (iPhone or Android) will work fine. A computer with a webcam will work fine. An iPad will work fine. You may also be able to use a stand-alone video camera if you know how to share the files from it.
2. You will need a device that can download the audio file and play it back through earbuds or headphones.
3. Many of us use the same device for both, but you may find it easier to use two different devices.
4. Download the audio file from the provided link.
5. Download and print the text file to read (or you can read it on your screen).
6. You will need to record yourself reading (or singing) along with the audio file we provided. You listen through the earbuds or headphones so that on your recording we only hear your voice and not the sound from the audio file.
7. If at all possible, hold your recording device so that your recording is in landscape or horizontal mode.
8. Then, make a video of yourself as you read (or sing) the piece along with the provided recording.
9. To submit your video you can upload it from your device to an internet sharing service like Google drive, dropbox, or you can email it using maildrop. You can also save it to a USB “stick” drive and drop it off to us, or, if you have an iPhone you can stop by the church and “airdrop” it to Rev. Smith. If it is a small file you may be able to email it or send it attached to a text message to Rev. Smith.
